Open Forum & Congregational Meeting – January 29 @ 6:30 pm

This will be a meeting open to the members of both of our campuses as three of the items being discussed will affect all the members of our church.

- 1) Additional staffing update and recommendations to two new positions. A) a full-time worship coordinator position for us as 1 church on 2 campuses. The job description summary will be shared at this meeting. This position will be

funded by the compensation that is available because of the partnership with Time of Grace. *NOTE: This position has been one that has been discussed at St. Peter for almost 10 years and The CORE for the past 5 years;* B) a Youth & Volunteer staff position. The job description is being finalized right now, but these are two areas of need that we have identified for some time at the St. Peter campus specifically but would also be of benefit to The CORE campus. This position (youth specific) was already approved by the congregation in the 2016-17 budget and we have been paying ourselves monthly for it even though it has gone unfilled. *NOTE: This position will not require additional budgetary expenses as it is already in our current budget.*

- 2) Discussion on recommended updated roles and responsibilities of our five pastors – with our partnership with Time of Grace and our current pastoral staff gifts and strengths, as well the desire to best carry out the five roots that we believe are vital for our church to be the church God wants us to be, our leaders have updated recommendations regarding the roles and areas of ministry oversight for our pastors.
- 3) 1C2C (1 Church on 2 Campuses) Vision Plan – overview and communicating of the updated mission and vision plan of our church for both campuses including common values, passion and mission, etc.)
