### Custodian Needed (FVL/St. Peter)

FVL is in need of hiring a part-time (approx. 30 hrs/wk) "second shift" custodian beginning immediately. This position rotates between two people at FVL during the hours of 5:30 pm – 10 pm M-F during the school year. In addition, *this position will perform custodial duties here at St. Peter between 3:15 pm – 5:30 pm M-F during the school year.* This position also helps cover weekend events at FVL. Hours in the summer are flexible. Main duties include cleaning classrooms and commons areas, vacuuming, scrubbing floors and securing entrances. Must be able to lift 25-50 lbs. Health insurance is available for the employee or employee and dependents. A 401k match is also provided. ### School Choice Program at St. Peter

St. Peter is looking forward to its fifth year in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program. All qualifying families are encouraged to apply and turn in all necessary information by the April 20 deadline. Students entering 5K, 1<sup>st</sup> grade, 9<sup>th</sup> grade or transferring from public school or homeschool are eligible to participate.
