School CHOICE Program @ St. Peter

St. Peter participates in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program. New in 2018-19, the number of students eligible to receive a voucher from each school district will increase. The eligibility income for families will also increase. WPCP applications opened on Feb. 1 and all qualifying families are encouraged to apply by the **APRIL 20 deadline**. This state funded program gives parents the opportunity to have their child's tuition fully funded. Students entering 5K, 1st Grade, 9th Grade or transferring from public school are eligible. You may apply using the link on St. Peter School's website – www.922church.com. Families can use either their 2016 or 2017 taxable adjustable gross income to qualify for the program.
