SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM AT ST. PETER—

Students entering 5K, 1st grade, 9th grade or transferring from public school or homeschool are eligible to participate. This state-funded program gives parents the opportunity to have their child's tuition fully funded. Note: Families that already have a voucher need to reapply and provide proof of residency.
