### **BEFORE SCHOOL AND AFTER SCHOOL**

**BUS—**Tuesday, September 3, is the first day of school for all students in the Freedom School District. If your child rides the bus in the morning, all St. Peter students are brought to Freedom Elementary School and then transfer onto one bus that takes them to St. Peter. If your child rides the bus home, one bus takes St. Peter students to the high school and then students transfer to their bus that takes them home. Next week, we will provide stickers for students that ride the bus that has their name and bus route. Mr. Punzel will also be at Freedom High School after school on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday helping students find their correct afternoon bus.

### **FVL STUDENT PASSPORTS—**

**SCHOOL VISITORS**—Parents are always welcome at school. School visitors should use the main entrance #1. During the school day, our exterior doors are locked. Visitors should follow the instructions located at the main entrance for entry. Between 7:55 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., please use the doorbell for entry and then come to the school office to sign in and receive a visitor badge.

**BOX TOPS FOR EDUCATION—NEW THIS YEAR**—new labels that offer no more clipping needed; all you need is your smartphone and the Box Tops app. The new and improved Box Tops mobile app uses technology to scan your store receipt (within 14 days of purchase), find participating products, and instantly add Box Tops to our school's earnings online. Traditional Box Tops cut-outs are being phased out of production but continue to be found on many products throughout the transition to the new Box Tops labels. There are 2 cabinets with a drawer in each to collect these cut-outs—one is located just outside the school kitchen door near the main school entrance and the other is in the Church Gathering Area, just inside the main church entrance doors. Please also encourage your relatives to sign up for the app and select our school to scan or collect Box Tops which benefit our school. Every little bit helps.

**HOT LUNCH AND MILK TICKETS**—Hot lunch tickets are sold in the school office. Students can purchase hot lunch and milk tickets in the mornings from 7:35 to 7:50 a.m. Parents can purchase hot lunch or milk tickets at any time in the school office. **The 2019-20 hot lunch prices are \$2.90 per lunch for 3K & 4K, and \$3.20 per lunch for 5K-8<sup>th</sup> grade.** Milk tickets are 25 cents each. Tickets are sold in multiples of 5, and hot lunch tickets include a milk. **Please have the student's name written on the back of these tickets, and also circle the Entrée number choice on the hot lunch ticket, so we know what your child is planning to eat when we take our lunch count in the morning. Parents, please make sure that your child always has a hot lunch ticket or a cold lunch packed every day.**
