INFORMATION—If it becomes necessary to close school and our early childhood center because of bad weather or any other emergency, notice will be given to WFRV Channel 5, NBC Channel 26, and WBAY Channel 2. Parents who signed up for a cell phone text alert at the beginning of the school year will be sent a text if school is closed or delayed. Since some cell phone carriers do not allow these texts to be received, all parents will also receive an email alert if school is closed or delayed. School closings or delays are posted on our school website. Any time St. Peter Lutheran School is closed or delayed because of bad weather, our early childhood center is also closed or delayed. Any time FREEDOM PUBLIC SCHOOLS are closed or delayed

because of bad weather, we are closed or delayed.

PAPER RECYCLING FUNDRAISER—

St. Peter Lutheran School is having a paper recycling fundraiser from Wednesday, December 26th through Tuesday, January 1st (please note the change of the ending date). We will be collecting any paper and non-wax coated paper and cardboard (gift wrapping paper is not accepted). We receive \$100 per ton of paper. Proceeds from the paper drive will benefit our school. A dumpster will be located next to the 1910 Center (old school building next to Pastor Bill's home) during this timeframe.
