INFORMATION—If it becomes necessary to close school and our early childhood center because of bad weather or any other emergency, notice will be given to WFRV Channel 5, WBAY Channel 2, and NBC Channel 26. Parents who signed up for a cell phone text alert at the beginning of the school year will be sent a text if school is closed or delayed. Since some cell phone carriers do not allow these texts to be received, all parents will also receive an email alert if school is closed or delayed. School closings or delays are also posted on our school website. Any time St. Peter Lutheran School is closed or delayed because of bad weather, our early childhood center is also closed or delayed. Any time Freedom Public Schools are closed or delayed because of bad weather, we are closed or delayed.

SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM AT

ST. PETER—St. Peter is looking forward to its fourth year in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program. New in 2018-2019, the number of students eligible to receive a voucher from each school district will increase to 3%. The eligibility income for families will also increase to 220%. WPCP applications will open on February 1, all qualifying families are encouraged to apply by the April 20 deadline. Students entering 5K, 1st grade, 9th grade or transferring from public school are eligible. This state funded program gives parents the opportunity to have their child's tuition fully funded. As soon as WPCP applications open, the link will be posted on St. Peter Lutheran School's website. FVL School members also participating in the program include Emanuel, New London; St. Mark, Green Bay; St. Paul, Appleton; Trinity, Neenah; Martin Luther, Oshkosh; Trinity, Brillion; St. Paul, Green Bay; and Fox Valley Lutheran High School.

PAPER RECYCLING—St. Peter Lutheran School is having a paper recycling drive from December 26th through January 7th. We will be collecting any paper and non-wax coated paper and cardboard (gift wrapping paper is not accepted). Proceeds from the paper drive benefit our school's technology, library, field trip, and athletic equipment needs.
