REGISTRATION FOR 18-19 SCHOOL

YEAR—This week, current school families received, via email, online registration information for the 18-19 school year using our School Speak system. **Current families are asked to complete the online registration forms by Wednesday, February 28.**

Accurate enrollment information is needed for the St. Peter Board of Education to carry out its recently adopted classroom size enrollment procedures. **Current school families that do not register by Wednesday, February 28 are not guaranteed a classroom seat for the 18-19 school year.**

SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM AT ST. PETER—St. Peter Lutheran School participates in the the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program. New in 2018-2019, the number of students eligible to receive a voucher from each school district will increase. The eligibility income for families will also increase. WPCP applications opened on February 1; all qualifying families are encouraged to apply and turn in all necessary information by the April 20 deadline. Students entering 5K, 1st grade, 9th grade, or transferring from public school are eligible. This state funded program gives parents the opportunity to have their child's tuition fully funded. You may apply using the link on St. Peter Lutheran School's website. Below are the eligible income limits to qualify for the program. Families can use either their 2016 or 2017 taxable adjustable gross income to qualify for the program:

- Two person family: \$35,728
- Three person family: \$51,924
- Four person family: \$61,120
- Five Person family: \$70,316
- Six Person family: \$79,512

LUTHER PREP PRESENTATION—Pastor Evan Chartrand who serves at Luther Prep in Watertown, Wisconsin will be on campus on Wednesday, February 21 to give a presentation to our 5th-8th grade students at 2:25 p.m. Luther Prep is a high school that is owned by the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod. The mission of the high school is to encourage students to consider serving in the full-time public ministry. Pastor Chartrand will share information about Luther Prep and encourage our students to consider serving as a pastor or teacher.

PIZZA FUNDRAISER ON SATURDAY, APRIL 7TH—It is time again for our spring pizza fundraiser. Two times a year parents, upper grade students, and supporters of St. Peter Lutheran School get together on a Saturday morning in our school and make four varieties of pizza. Last fall we made 768 pizzas, and our school received \$2,570 from this sale. **An order form is attached to today's newsletter. Order forms and payments need to be returned to the school office by Wednesday, March 14th.** Proceeds

from our pizza sales help pay for transportation to field trips, updated technology equipment, books for our school library, accelerated reader prizes, school plays, equipment and officials for our athletic programs, and entry fees for academic competitions. Brown paper grocery bags are also needed for packaging pizza. Grocery bags can be dropped off in the school office.

Volunteers are also needed to make pizzas on Saturday, April 7th starting at 8:00 a.m. With enough volunteers, we should be done making pizzas before 11 a.m.—**a volunteer sign-up sheet is in the office.**

VOLUNTEERS TO TAKE PIZZA ORDERS AFTER CHURCH—Would you like to volunteer to take orders for our St. Peter School pizza fundraiser before or after church services at St. Peter or The CORE?
