EARLY RELEASE AND FACULTY

IN-SERVICE—On Thursday, February 14, 5K-8th grade students will be dismissed at 12:10 p.m. Your faculty has an in-service planned from 1:00-2:30 p.m. There is **NO SCHOOL** on Friday, February 15 for 5K-8th grades. **THERE is NO SCHOOL** on Monday, February 18 for 5K-8th grades. On Monday, February 18, your staff will be working with teachers from St. Mark Lutheran, Green Bay, on our new science curriculum that will be used beginning in the 19-20 school year.

SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM AT ST. PETER—

St. Peter Lutheran School participates in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program. For the 2019-20 school year, the number of students eligible to receive a voucher from each school district will increase. The eligibility income for families also will increase. Parents, check out the WPCP information attached to the newsletter. WPCP applications are now open—all qualifying families are encouraged to apply by the April 20 deadline. Students entering 5K, 1st grade, 9th grade, or transferring from public school or homeschool are eligible. This state-funded program gives parents the opportunity to have their child's tuition fully funded. Note: Families that already have a voucher need to reapply and provide proof of residency. Parents can visit our website (www.922church.com) and click on the

St. Peter School tab to find the WPCP link for the online application. Below are the eligible income limits to qualify for the program. Families can use either their 2017 or 2018 taxable adjustable gross income to qualify for the program.

- Two person family: \$36,212
- Three person family: \$52,716
- Four person family: \$62,220
- Five person family: \$71,724
- Six person family: \$81,228
