WISCONSIN SCHOOL CHOICE PRESENTATION HELD AT ST. PETER LUTHERAN—4K, 5K, and 8th grade parents, on Tuesday, February 5 from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the St. Peter Lutheran Ministry Center, Mr. Ben Priebe, director of enrollment at FVL, and Phil Punzel, principal at St. Peter Lutheran, will give a presentation on the Wisconsin Parental School Choice program. Parents will learn how they can use this program, where to find the application, and what they need to complete the application. The Wisconsin Parental School Choice program pays for student tuition at St. Peter, at a number of our other FVL Schools partner schools in the Fox Valley, and at Fox Valley Lutheran High School.
