5K-8th GRADE SCHOOL REGISTRATION FOR 19-20 SCHOOL YEAR—Registration for the 19-20 school year is now open. Current school families, **please log in to your School Speak account, and on your home page, click on the "Re-Registration 2019-20" link in the navy blue box on the left side** (if you are using the Mobile version, on the top left of the home page, click Menu, and then click on School

to have it show you the category choices--click on Re-Registration 2019-20 to begin). Follow the prompts for Step 1 as you update/confirm your family profiles with your information (parent and student information) for our school communication and emergency notifications--this information will stay in our School Speak system, and you will be able to edit your information if any changes are needed in the future. Continue to Step 2 to complete your 19-20 registration of your student(s) through School Speak and make sure to click SUBMIT at the end of the process. *If you do not remember your School Speak login information, please contact Michelle Tellock at michelle.tellock@922ministries.com and she will have your login and password emailed to you.* Current families that are enrolling a new child in 5K-8th grade are asked to enter this child under "new student." Tuition information for the 19-20 School Year can be found on our school website under the Enrollment tab. **Current families are asked to complete the registration form by Wednesday, March 13.** Accurate enrollment information is needed for the St. Peter Board of Education to carry out its classroom size enrollment procedures. **Current school families that do not register by Wednesday, March 13, are not guaranteed a classroom seat for the 19-20 school year.** Thank you for your continued support of Christian education at St. Peter Lutheran School.

SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM AT ST. PETER—

St. Peter Lutheran School participates in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program. Parents can apply for and turn in all necessary documentation for the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program from now through the April 20, 2019 deadline. Students entering 5K, 1st grade, 9th grade, or transferring from public school or homeschool are eligible. This state-funded program gives parents the opportunity to have their child's tuition fully funded. Note: Families that already have a voucher need to reapply and provide proof of residency.
