**HOT LUNCH AND MILK TICKETS**—Hot lunch tickets are sold in the school office. Students can purchase hot lunch and milk tickets in the mornings from 7:35 to 7:50 a.m. Parents can purchase hot lunch or milk tickets at any time in the school office. **The 2018-19 hot lunch prices are \$2.90 per lunch for 3K & 4K, and \$3.20 per lunch for 5K-8<sup>th</sup> grade.** Milk tickets are 25 cents each. Tickets are sold in multiples of 5, and hot lunch tickets include a milk. **Please have the student's name written on the back of these tickets, and also circle the Entrée number choice on the hot lunch ticket, so we know what your child is planning to eat when we take our lunch count in the morning. Parents, please make sure that your child always has a hot lunch ticket or a cold lunch packed every day.**
