Please click on the News and Resources tab. In the upper right hand corner you will see the Renaissance Home Connect link. When you click on this link, you will be asked to enter your child's username and password. This is the same information that your child uses at school. If your child does not remember their username or password, please contact your child's home room teacher and they will share it with you.
