**SCHOOL FUNDRAISERS**—St. Peter Lutheran School uses fundraisers to generate revenue for non-budgetary items. Currently, our library and technology funds are supported by fundraisers and gifts. The field trip and athletic funds receive revenue through parent fees and fundraisers. During the school year, homemade pizzas are sold twice a year, Dairy Queen certificates are sold in the fall, and candy bars are sold in the spring. We also host Scoopie Nights at the Little Chute Culver's—a percentage of the evening's sales comes back to St. Peter. In previous years, we have hosted a book fair in the fall. This fall we are selling student artwork. The goals of our fundraisers are simple. First, we want to sell high quality products at a fair price. Second, we want to ensure that the amount of people hours put into the fundraiser is manageable. Finally, we want them to be profitable. Participating in fundraisers is 100% optional. Thank you in advance in helping our fundraisers be successful.
