

SMALL GROUP

This week, we will learn about the letter K. We will practice writing uppercase and lowercase K and decorate with key rubbings. The rest of our small group lessons will focus on STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) experiments. We will investigate color mixing, as well as ice melting. We will create ramps with tubes and blocks and test them with balls and cars. We will also do a sink/float exploration. We will hypothesize and then discuss which objects floated and which sank.
