SPECIAL REMINDERS

Heckrodt Nature Center Field Trip: The ECM students will visit the Heckrodt Wetland Reserve in Menasha on January 18. Please refer to the field trip sheet for more information. Note the special policy about chaperones for this field trip. Return the bottom portion of the sheet to your child's teacher by this Monday, January 14.

Winter Gear: Please send your child with proper winter gear (snowpants, hat, gloves/mittens, boots, etc.) everyday. Please place in a reusable cloth grocery or tote bag, with all items labeled with name or initials.

Snow Days/Delays: In case of inclement weather, we will follow the St. Peter Lutheran School decisions.
