

An Old School Response to Christ's Birth Luke 2:15-20

Luke 2:11 "Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord."

How will you respond to this good news?

Luke 2:15-16 When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about." So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger.

We respond...

- Immediately...
- by believing...
- with a faith that intentionally pursues Jesus.

Luke 2:17-18 When they had seen him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child, and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them.

We respond by sharing this good news with others.

Luke 2:19-20 But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart. The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told.

We respond by treasuring and pondering these things and
by glorifying and praising God for these things.

Points to Ponder:

Write down some thoughts explaining how each of our 5 roots cultivate the old school response to the Savior's birth which we heard about in the message today.

- Gather (Regular worship as a member of the body of Christ):

- Group (Doing life together in community with other believers):

- Grow (Making God and his Word a daily part of your home life):
